Getting an MBA can position both emerging and experienced business professionals for a variety of meaningful and lucrative careers — here are some jobs you can get with an MBA.



The <u>national average salary for MBA graduates in 2020 was nearly \$138,000.</u> That said, salary ranges fluctuate based on location, job role and level of experience. For example, MBA graduates in the northeastern United States make about \$30,000 more upon hire compared to MBA graduates seeking employment in the southern United States.

In short, the data show that MBA graduates have the valuable opportunity of working in a variety of positions — and make a significant salary doing so.

#### Online MBA Program Features

**AACSB-Accredited College:** Most widely recognized business accreditation in the world

**Enrollment Timeline:** 5 entry points – January, March, June, August and October

**Concentrations Available:** 1) Human Resource Management 2) International Business 3) Business Analytics – Kent State also now offers two graduate certificates that align within concentrations: Business Analytics and Human Resource Management.

**Study Abroad Opportunity:** Option to participate in a short-term study abroad program, which fulfills required elective credits

**Case-Based Curriculum:** Accelerated 8-week modules allow students to apply concepts through the use of case study projects

**Nationally-Ranked Faculty:** Courses are taught by full-time faculty who are noted academics and/or experienced business leaders.

**Prior Work Experience:** Not Required

Prior Business-Related Degree: Not Required

**Go At Your Own Pace:** Take a full-time course load and complete the program in as few as 12 months, or adjust your course load to your work and personal commitments and complete it over a longer period of time.

**Stackable Graduate Certificate Pathway:** If starting a graduate program seems like too much of a commitment right now, simply enroll in one of our graduate certificate programs that can stack into an MBA. Choose either the **Leadership and Management Graduate Certificate** or the **Financial Management Graduate Certificate**. Both certificate programs consist of 5 courses, which appear on an official university transcript and earn a frame worthy certificate. Those students who are interested in earning a Business Analytics Graduate Certificate can apply these courses toward an MBA Concentration in Business Analytics.

### **Online MBA Frequently Asked Questions**



Here is a list of frequently asked questions, for your convenience, as you consider applying to Kent State's Online MBA program.

#### Q: Is an undergraduate degree in an area of business required to get the MBA?

A: No. To be considered for the program, applicants must have a bachelor's degree. A significant percentage of our Online MBA students have a non-business bachelor's degree.

#### Q: If an applicant's undergraduate degree is not in business, are additional courses required?

**A:** No additional courses are required. However, a set of pre-course webinars must be completed by all students, no matter their undergraduate degree, prior to selecting quantitative courses. Webinars in accounting, spreadsheets (Excel), statistics, finance, and economics prepare students to enter MBA courses with the confidence to succeed. Webinars are self-paced and can be repeated. They serve as a review for those with a business education background and as a learning tool for those without a business education background.

#### Q: What math knowledge and skills do applicants need to be proficient in to start the program?

A: Students should be proficient in algebra.

#### Q: Is the GMAT or GRE a requirement in all cases?

- A: GMAT/GRE can be waived by meeting the following criteria:
  - Cumulative GPA of 3.2 or greater in a bachelor's degree, or an awarded graduate degree.
  - Completed two quantitative courses, such as advanced algebra, statistics, or the equivalent with grades of "B" (3.0) or higher.
  - Two or more years of full-time study in a degree granting program in the United States and successful completion of English, communication, and writing intensive courses (International applicants).
  - For GRE/GMAT waiver consideration, please submit a request via the <u>form here.</u>

#### Q: What is course delivery like?

A: Classes are taught asynchronously, which means students do not need to access the course at set times with other students or the instructor. Online classes are delivered within the Canvas learning management system, which contains all course materials, including lectures, videos, course assignments, discussion boards, etc..

#### Q: What are the major differences between Online and Executive MBA (EMBA) programs?

A: While both programs are designed for the working professional, there are three major differences. The Online MBA program is delivered fully online and the EMBA program is offered in a hybrid format that includes a mix of online and in-person instruction, and includes beginning and ending residencies as well as an international business experience. The Online program offers flexibility for the student to pursue the MBA at their own pace; the EMBA is a cohort program where all students progress together through a set of courses, completing the program in 19 months.

Finally, students in the EMBA program are typically more experienced professionals, with an average of 15 years work experience, compared to an average of 8 years work experience for Online MBA students.

#### Q: When does the Online MBA program begin?

A: This flexible program can be started at 5 entry points each year: January, March, June, August and October. Application deadlines are typically about six weeks before the start of the intended term.

#### Q: What happens if I have to stop the program for work or family issues?

A: Students can flexibly not enroll in one or more 8-week terms up to one year. When a year or more is necessary, a formal Leave of Absence request is required to keep the student active in the University's system.

#### Q: How long do I have to complete the Online MBA Program?

A: Students have six years to complete the Online MBA, however the average time to complete the program for those working full-time while pursuing the MBA is two to two and a half years. Time approved as a Leave of Absence does not count toward the six-year limit.

#### Q: How are employer tuition benefits handled by the Bursar's Office?

A: Kent State has deferred billing for those with tuition benefits. A form is submitted each semester with the student/employee's information. Find more details about employer tuition assistance and the form.



### **Online MSBA Frequently Asked Questions**



Here is a list of frequently asked questions, for your convenience, as you consider applying to Kent State's Online Business Analytics program.

#### Q: Is an undergraduate degree in a specific area of business required to get the MSBA?

A: No. MSBA is a multi-disciplinary program and applicants with bachelor's degree in science, technology, engineering, mathematics, or business can join the program.

#### Q. I work full-time. Can I still join the Online MSBA program?

A: Yes. In fact, most of our online MSBA students are working professionals who complete the program part-time.

#### Q: Is the GMAT or GRE a requirement for the MSBA program?

A: No. The MSBA program does not require a GMAT or a GRE score.

#### Q: How many core and elective courses does the MSBA program require you to complete?

A: The MSBA program at Kent State is a 30-credit-hour program with eight required core courses and two elective courses.

#### Q: Is there an option to complete a graduate certificate program instead of a full masters program?

A: Yes. By completing 12-credit hours (four courses), you can earn a graduate certificate in Business Analytics.
